Island Safeguarding Officer (ISO) Vacancy

We are seeking to appoint a positive, discrete but determined Safeguarding Officer for Sark.

Main responsibilities of this role:

- ◆ To be the named Designated Safeguarding Officer and to safeguard and protect the community of Sark
- ◆ To receive safeguarding referrals and co-ordinate the procedures which address and prioritise the needs of those affected
- ◆ To liaise with the Safeguarding officials both on and off the Island as appropriate
- ◆ To deliver safeguarding training, update and implement policies and procedures and share learning, with staff and volunteers in positions of responsibility
- ◆ To ensure personal professional understanding is up to date and in line with current best practice and legislation

The Education Review highlighted the need for a named and qualified safeguarding officer for the Island.

The ISO will be the Designated Safeguarding Officer and will chair a multi-disciplinary panel involving trained professionals from health, education, the church, and the constabulary.

The panel will work with the ISO to monitor and support the safeguarding needs of adults and children on Sark.

The role does not receive a salary, but expenses are paid in line with CSO salaries and expenses. The role is line managed by the Senior Administrator and supervised by a fellow Safeguarding professional.

Candidates should have experience or qualifications in Safeguarding. Those without qualifications must be willing to train and be subject to a full DBS check. Applications should be made in writing to the Education Review Implementation Manager, Beverley Martin, stating why you feel you are suitable for the role.
