## **ROAD TRAFFIC COMMITTEE TRAFFIC REGULATIONS**

**(Order No.2 of 20<sup>th</sup> July, 2010)**

These Regulations are made under the following Ordinances with immediate effect:

The Road Traffic (Tractors and Invalid Carriages)(Amendment)(Sark)Ordinance 1972  
The Road Traffic (Horse-Drawn Vehicles)(Amendment)(Sark)Ordinances, 1972 & 1980

### **TRACTORS**

#### **Owners must fully instruct those driving tractors on their behalf**

- 1. THE AVENUE:** Until further notice, or failing such notice until the 30<sup>th</sup> September 2010, the Avenue **WILL BE CLOSED TO TRACTORS between 11.00 am and 5.00 pm.**  
The only exception is for access to premises for LEGITIMATE DELIVERIES when drivers must travel in an East to West direction; this applies to all seven days of the week.  
**The Avenue is from La Collinette to the junction outside the Post Office.**  
**The direct road from the Post Office to the Church will be closed to tractors between those hours except for legitimate access to properties thereon, seven days a week.**
- 2. BOATS, BOAT TRAILERS and LARGE LOADS:** to be moved so as not to coincide with the arrival of the passenger ferries (both loSS and Manche îles) and the consequential bus movements.
- 3. PARKING:** is **NOT ALLOWED** between The Power Station and The Visitors' Centre or The Church along the line of The Avenue between **11.00 am and 6.00 pm** except for legitimate business.  
Parking is **NOT ALLOWED** between the NatWest Bank and the Pomme de Chien campsite lane, and between La Collinette and Rue Hotton ("Mermaid Lane").
- 4. UNATTENDED TRACTORS:** must be switched off and the brakes applied. Tractor drivers are requested to park with due care and attention to other road users and **OFF THE ROAD** if possible.
- 5. FORK LIFTS and BUILDING MACHINERY:** when moving between sites, respect must be shown for other road users, especially Horse Drawn vehicles. Forks must **always** be protected and kept below the waistline when on the move on roadways used by the public. Fork lifts and JCBs require permission from the Constable if they are to be driven down the Harbour Hill.
- 6. ARRANGEMENTS ON THE MASELINE AND CREUX JETTIES:** The Harbourmaster or his Deputy have control of all vehicle movements and parking on the jetties and in the area between as far up as the water tanks on Harbour Hill.  
Creux Harbour arm should always be kept clear in case of emergency evacuation.
- 7. LA COLLINETTE:** The parking of trailers is banned in La Collinette Lay-by at all times except for Public Works vehicles and trailers.

## **HORSE-DRAWN VEHICLES**

**Owners must fully instruct those driving carriages on their behalf**

8. **ONE WAY TRAFFIC:** Until further notice or, failing such notice, until the 30<sup>th</sup> September, 2010, The Avenue between the junction outside the Post Office and La Collinette will be one way without stopping from **West to East** for Horse-drawn Vehicles between **11.00 am and 5.00 pm**.
9. **ROAD CLOSED:** carriages using the direct road between the Church and the Visitors' Centre, cannot in that direction, turn left outside the Visitors' Centre, back towards The Avenue because of the camber and the possibility of Horse Drawn Carriages overturning.  
**THIS NO LEFT TURN APPLIES AT ALL TIMES.**
10. **STANDING or PLYING FOR HIRE:** A person being in charge of a horse-drawn vehicle which is used for the carriage of passengers for hire or reward shall not, prior to **9.00 am** on any day, offer such vehicle for such use either by standing or plying for hire.
11. **PARKING:** is **NOT ALLOWED** on the roadway from La Collinette down to the Power Station. Carriages drivers are **ONLY ALLOWED** to park, procure & board passengers in La Collinette lay-by. If this is full, additional parking is available on the roadway opposite the NatWest Bank (with carriages facing north); customers may be boarded at this location.
12. **SUNDAYS:** all the above regulations apply to every day of the week, including Sundays.

**Vehicle Movements and Parking in Harbour Areas**

**Do not leave dogs unattended in the harbour areas; dogs must be kept on a lead at all times in Maseline Harbour.**
